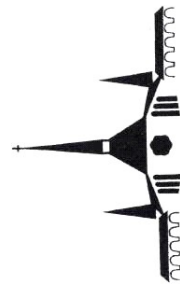
Our youth will collect dollars (or more) in soup pots after the 8:00, 9:00 and 11:00am worship services.
